► High school students in block schedules who are classified as 10th graders in the fall of their second year in high school and as juniors by spring testing of their second year are permitted to take GEE 21 English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies for the first time during spring testing of their second year.

► Option 2 grade 8 students must take LEAP 21 as indicated in the above schedule and may take *i* LEAP during makeup testing, as detailed in the test administration manuals.

\*The *old* Graduation Exit Examination (GEE) is a district function.

Note: In the July 2006 retest, for students who test in three or four content areas of GEE 21, the schedule in the District and School Test Coordinators Manual for Summer 2006 must be followed .
